

LIFE SKILLS FROM PSALM 37

Part 4: What Delight Looks Like

TEXT: Psalm 37:4 NKJV

ANOTHER SIDE OF DELIGHTING IN THE LORD

- Delighting in the Lord is honoring the Lord with your life **(Isaiah 58:13-14 NKJV)**
 1. We don't treat the Sabbath today as different **(Romans 14:5-6 NKJV)**
 - a. The principle of a day of rest is still valid
 2. The principle of honoring God is still the same
 - a. Not doing your own ways - looking to do things God's ways
 - b. Not finding your own pleasure - not all about comfort or convenience **(Galatians 5:22-24 NKJV)**
 - c. Not speaking your own words **(Ephesians 4:29 NKJV)**
 3. Then - after putting these principles into practice
 - a. God causes you to excel **(Matthew 6:33 NKJV)**
 - b. Gives you the desires of your heart - your desires are in line with Him

COMMITTING YOUR WAY TO THE LORD (Psalm 37:5 NKJV)

- Trusting God with your life
 1. Very similar to the prayer of consecration that Jesus prayed **(Luke 22:41-42 NKJV)**
 - a. 'If it be your will' is not how you pray every prayer **(James 1:5-8 NKJV)**
 2. Commit means to roll your works over on the Lord
 - a. This is not absolving you of responsibility
 - b. This is finding the will of God for your life **(Proverbs 16:3 NKJV)**
