A LADY WHO BELIEVED (Mark 5:25-31 NKJV)

- An unknown woman in a bad situation
 - 1. Her problem was long term
 - 2. She was facing a financial crisis spent all her money on doctors
 - 3. There must be a want, a desire for different (*Proverbs 21:25 NLT*)
- She heard of Jesus
 - 1. Faith comes by hearing (Romans 10:17 NKJV)
 - 2. What you hear is vitally important (Mark 4:24 NLT) (1 Thessalonians 5:12 NKJV) (John 16:13 NKJV)
- What she did was not easy
 - 1. She was not allowed to be in a crowd with her condition
 - 2. She had to push past people blocking her way to Jesus
 - Her actions were based on her desire and what she believed
 - 4. The idea that if it's God, it's easy not accurate (1 Timothy 6:12 NKJV)
- · Her words as well as her actions were based on what she heard and believed
 - 1. She said if only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well
 - 2. Her words were based on what she believed about Jesus
 - 3. Your words can be based on what you hear/see in the scriptures (2 Corinthians 5:17 NKJV) (2 Corinthians 5:21 NKJV) (1 John 1:9 NKJV) (1 Peter 2:24 NKJV)
- She was commended, not criticized, by Jesus
 - 1. Jesus commended her for her faith
 - 2. Your faith is important to the Lord (Hebrews 11:6 NKJV)
