HELP LORD!

LIFT UP YOUR EYES (Psalm 121:1-2 ESV)

- A phrase used in Scripture
 - 1. Not necessarily seeing with your physical sight
 - 2. Jesus used this phrase (John 4:35 ESV)
 - 3. God told Abraham to lift up his eyes (Genesis 13:14-15 ESV)
- God told Joshua to "see" something that was not obvious (Joshua 6:1-2 ESV)
 - 1. Jericho was a walled city
 - 2. God told Joshua to "see" something that was not visible
 - 3. Joshua could have pushed back mentally

LIFT UP YOUR EYES AND SEE YOU HAVE HELP

- This is based on what God has said (Hebrews 13:5-6 ESV)
 - 1. This is different from seeing is believing
 - 2. Based on what God has said, you can see that you are not abandoned
 - 3. You believe / see that God is your helper
 - 4. When you believe the Lord is your helper
- When help was promised (1 Samuel 11:1-4 NKJV)
 - 1. The people of Jabesh were living in a pressure cooker situation
 - 2. Saul, a new king, rallied the people of Israel (1 Samuel 11:9-10 NKJV)
 - 3. The people of Jabesh chose to believe the promise
