STRENGTH IS AN ADVANTAGE

- For life
 - 1. Business negotiations
 - 2. Relationships neediness repels
 - 3. Longevity not just cardio fit, but muscular strength
- There is strength with God (Psalm 29:11 NKJV)
 - 1. Closer to Him is a stronger place

A STRONG SIDE KING

- Hezekiah had a strong heart for the Lord (2 Chronicles 31:20-21 NKJV)
 - 1. He lived strong before God
 - 2. He had a heart for God's Kingdom how he treated God's house/temple
 - 3. He had a heart for God's Word the law
 - 4. He had a heart for the person of God
- Hezekiah had a strong action orientation (2 Chronicles 32:1-5 NKJV)
 - 1. He was aware of trouble but did not hide not paralyzed by the problem
 - 2. He took action and strengthened the nation
- Hezekiah had a strong belief in God's ability and willingness to help them (2 Chronicles 32:6-9 NKJV)
 - 1. He believed God was more powerful than the Assyrian army
 - 2. He believed that God was on their side and would help them
 - 3. His strong faith in God was the basis for his encouraging words

LIVING ON THE STRONG SIDE IN YOUR LIFE

- A strong heart for God (Matthew 6:10 NKJV)
 - 1. God's kingdom is important even more than your kingdom
 - 2. A love for God's Word (Psalm 1:2 NKJV)
 - 3. Seeking a relationship with God
- A strong action orientation
 - 1. A strong Christian life is not passive (1 Corinthians 16:13-14 NKJV)
- · A strong belief in God's power and willingness to help you
 - 1. Believing that God is for you
 - 2. Believing that God is powerful (Jeremiah 32:17 NLT)
 - 3. Believing that God is good and will be good to you
